

# Supply List for Introduction to Painting (Acrylic)

These items should be available at Hobby Lobby, Michaels and other craft supply stores.

1. Sketchbook: 8x10 or 8.5x11 inch notebook any brand. Hard bound or spiral bound will work.



2. Pencils: #2, generic brands will do
3. Acrylic Paint:
  - Brand: Mastertouch is a great brand. Feel free to use the Hobby Lobby or Michaels store brands when starting out painting.
  - Size: start with a medium or small size and add to your paints as your projects progress
  - Colors: Student choice. The following colors are recommended to start
    - Black, white, red, yellow, blue
4. Mixed set of brushes:
  - Type/made of: Natural and synthetic brushes would both be acceptable options.
  - Size: A basic starter set would do if it has the following with other brushes ranging from size 1 to 10
    - Small & medium *Round* brush
    - Small & medium *Square* brush
    - Additionally, 1 large *Square* brush, with a 1 inch width
5. Oil Pastels: Mastertouch, Hobby Lobby and Michaels brands, or whatever you may already have.
6. Canvases: Student grade stretched canvases, size recommendations below
  - small: 8 x 10 inches
  - medium: 16 x 20 inches
  - large: up to 3 x 4 feet (if you would like to work larger)
