## Supplies:

First 4-5 weeks, you will need these supplies:
Something to paint on (panels, canvas, paper, etc.)
Paint (oils or acrylics, watercolors look for similar names):

- Titanium White (check pigment, NO PW 4)
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Permanent Rose or Thalo Red Rose or Quinacridone Rose
- Pthalo Blue Green Shade (in this case, I have a brand preference for oil colors -
- Utrecht available through Dick Blick)
- Ivory Black

For those wanting to try water mixable oils, I suggest the Cobra brand. Your colors would be:

- Titanium White
- Primary Yellow
- Primary Magenta
- Primary Cyan
- Ivory Black

Painting medium (optional) i.e. linseed oil, Liquin, acrylic glazing medium, etc.
Brushes: Flats or Filberts in a variety of sizes including a flat that is at least approximately $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide
Palette Knife
Gamsol (if using oil paint) and 2 glass containers ABSOLUTELY NO ODORLESS TURPS!!!
Water (if using water based paints) and 2 containers
Paper Towels or rags
Palette
Mirror
Highly Suggested: value viewer (such as this one, https://www.amazon.com/Cottage-Mills-Color-Evaulator-Filterx/dp/B001FQZC8I)

- Cadmium Yellow Lemon
- Cadmium Red Light
- Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Umber, Vandyke Brown, or Transparent Oxide Brown
